The contest will be held at the Club level, and is sponsored by the Optimist Club of New Ulm. Entrants must be from the New Ulm, MN area (either living or attending school within 25 miles of New Ulm).

2. Photographers must be in Grades 1 through 12 (based on 2024-2025 school year). Winners will be chosen in two age divisions: Grades 1-6 and Grades 7-12.
3. An entry form (see attached) must be completed for each entry and attached to the back of the entry, and signed by the photographer and parent(s) or guardian(s).

filter in an e ents s ould e used, other than basic cropping of the photo. Do not fold photos or mats. Be sure to protect the photo by placing it between two pieces of thin cardboard. Mark all envelopes "DO NOT BEND"

There will be a monetary award for the top 5 winners in each age category: \$75 first place, \$50 second place, \$40 third place, \$30 fourth place, and \$25 fifth place. A People's Choice award from all entries will receive a cash prize of \$50. Entries will be displayed at the New Ulm Public Library Children's room after contest and during the People's Choice voting.
